Registration Instructions

1. Both partners to create their respective accounts on Sportssync
 - Tournament Link: <https://www.sportssync.asia/tournament/267>
2. Ensure DUPR account is linked to Sportssync
 - DUPR Registration Link: <https://dashboard.dupr.com/signup>
3. Register for appropriate* event on Sportssync
 - This will get you on the event *waitlist*
4. Make payment via PayNow (payment details provided during registration)
 - *Refer to Key Event Dates & Overview page for withdrawal policy and windows*
5. Once we confirm your payment you will be promoted to *confirmed*

* If you register for events on the same day and the schedules conflict, you will be expected to play both events **concurrently**

Venue Information

- Please note that tournament courts are shaded but outdoors, so do bring along your cap and sunblock
- Courts are unplayable in the event of rain. Do take note of the wet weather contingencies and dates
- There are vending machines and water cooler on the premise. Please hydrate sufficiently
- Toilets and shower facilities are available
- Nearest mall is IMM, directly opposite our courts

Tournament Information & Rules

General

- All players are to join the tournament Whatsapp community channel to receive real-time tournament updates:
- In case of rain, the schedule shall proceed as originally planned and postponed matches will be prioritized to complete within the same day
- In the event rain-delayed matches cannot complete within the same day, they will be postponed to wet weather-scheduled days (see Tournament Schedule). Players are to keep those dates available
- The organizer reserves the right to change the format of play to fit the tournament schedule
- Any player found to have violated the DUPR restrictions in their category will be defaulted without refund

Equipment & Gear

- The official tournament ball used is Franklin x40
- Only paddles that are USAP **or** UPA-A approved are allowed
- Players are to be dressed in appropriate sports attire. Only non-marking shoes are allowed on court



Tournament Information & Rules

Registration & Reporting

- All players are to report at the registration desk **30 mins before** the start of their respective categories
- Players are to be present at their designated courts during their scheduled session
- Matches will proceed sequentially and immediately after the previous match is over
- Any team who do not report to their respective courts **within 10 mins** of the start of their match will be considered to have given a walkover, with a default score of 11-0 / 15-0 / 21-0 awarded to the opponents
- Both teams are to report the final match score to their assigned facilitator after the end of every match
- Finalized match scores will be updated on our online tournament tracker: link will be shared at registration desk
- All matches will be submitted to DUPR for rating review within 1 month of the end of the tournament



Tournament Information & Rules

Matchplay – General

- Match formats are stated under Format of Play
- No time is allocated for warm up during the match. Each player shall get one practice serve before the match commences
- Each team is allowed **ONE** timeout (1 min) **per set**
- Each player is allowed **ONE** medical timeout (10 min) per match.
 - Do note that cramps & fatigue do not qualify for medical timeout
- All line calls should be loud, audible and prompt
- Spectators should not influence nor interfere with line call decisions
- Balls are considered out if they hit any external permanent structure (e.g. pillars, sunshade, overhead beams, etc.), even if they land within the court subsequently
- Good sportsmanship is expected of players. If there are recurring disputes, players can raise them to tournament officials

Tournament Information & Rules

Matchplay – Non-Officiated Matches

- Serving team is to call out the score loud and clear before every point
- Players are responsible for tracking score and player positions
- Receiving team has the final say regarding line calls, but the benefit of doubt should be given where possible
- If both teams are unsure of the call, the point shall be replayed
- Players should call out any self-committed rule violations as soon as the fault is committed
- If any external distraction arises during the point (e.g. ball enters court), the point shall be replayed

Tournament Information & Rules

Matchplay – Officiated Matches

Referees shall:

- Track and call out the score before every point
- Call foot faults, service faults, and general rule violations
- Weigh in on line calls if there are any disputes
- Have the final say on ruling decision

Players shall:

- Make line calls for baseline and sidelines, and centre line during serves
